Why: Mired in a disaster zone (natural, terrorist, or street protest), or rural/travel/wilderness area far from a hospital ... accidents, destructive weather, and terrorism happen, and all-too-often people are not capable of dealing with the emergency. Improper care of trauma can compound simple injuries, or even lead to death. Very few first aid programs address the issues of providing emergency care in a setting where 911 is overwhelmed or not immediately reachable. In this course, classroom instruction and Q&A are interwoven with practical work and problem-solving exercises. Hands-on practice – a most powerful learning tool – during scenarios comprises ~50% of class. 8:30am–6:30pm or 7pm both days, you come away with do-it-yourself care-giving confidence.

- **Beyond the 'Golden Hour':** wilderness/disaster/remote travel injury challenges & long-term patient care
 - **Patient Assessment System:** thorough patient exam, treatment, monitoring, safety, & documentation
 - **Orthopedic Injuries and Treatment:** Sprains, Strains, Fractures, and Spinal Cord Management
 - **Soft Tissue Injuries and Wound Treatment:** Contusions, Abrasions, Lacerations, Flap Avulsions, Amputations, Punctures, Impalements, Bites, Stings, Blisters, Burns, and Infections
 - **Environmental Injuries and Treatment:** Cold, Heat, Dehydration and Wilderness Survival
 - **Medical Emergencies and Critical Care:** Shock, Allergies, Shortness of Breath, Brain and Heart Problems
 - **Patient Movement:** Clearing a spine for patient movement; pre- and post-evacuation treatment
